THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION
THE TRANSFIGURATION OF THE LORD

What is Christianity finally about? These days, if you ask almost anyone who doesn't know the Bible, you'll probably hear an answer like this: "Being a good person" or "following the golden rule." No offense to the golden rule, but our faith is simply much stranger than that. This week's feast of the Transfiguration of the Lord is a luminous example of this. Jesus becomes radiantly and overwhelmingly beautiful. The glory of God literally shines forth from his body and even his clothes. Here we see that Christianity is not mainly a moral system but a relationship with God in Christ, one that finally makes human beings gloriously beautiful.

Now we can see our good and bad deeds in a new and de-centered way. Our morality isn't about a heaven or hell scorecard. It's about lives open (or closed) to transfiguration, lives capable of revealing the glory of God in Christ to the world. Spouses, children, friends, co-workers, priests, consecrated women and men, and so on — we are all called to let the beauty of Jesus make our lives beautiful, little by little. His beauty in us is the center of our faith.

WHAT ADORATION MEANS TO ME

Not having been raised in the Catholic Faith, I was completely unfamiliar with ADORATION. Even after my confirmation during Easter Vigil a mere fifteen years ago, I had no idea what a monstrance was or even more importantly what it contained. Two years ago, a group of women at St. Charles encouraged me about participating in ADORATION with the Seven Sisters Apostolate. Agreeing to partake in this group meant a commitment of spending an hour in ADORATION once a week, every week, for a year. This community of women had just provided me with an opportunity to wrap my head around spending some quality time with Jesus.

What happened next was transformative! It required that I put some effort into discerning how I would spend an hour being in the immediate presence of our Lord. The first hour I spent in ADORATION, I was struck by how entirely safe and secure I felt. As I began to pray, I could identify with Peter, James and John when they fell asleep in the Garden of Gethsemane. Being in ADORATION gave me a little taste of the comfort, warmth and security that those apostles surely must have felt wrapped in the presence of Jesus that left them with “the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding” (Philippians 4:7). When my hour had come to a close, I found myself reluctant to leave and reenter the “outside world.” ADORATION gave me a chance to appreciate the value of “Being still, and knowing that He is God” (Psalm 46:10).

I encourage everyone to come be in the presence of Jesus during ADORATION even if it is for 5 or 10 minutes! “Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known to God. And the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus” (Philippians 4:6-7).
