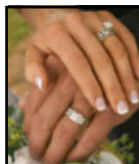

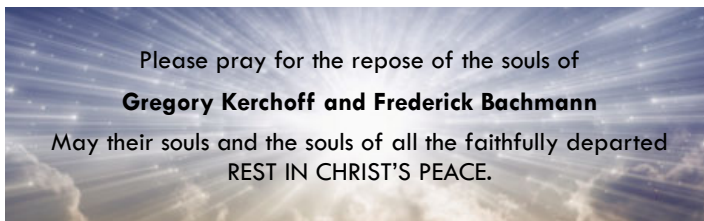

THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

24TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

When I was in second grade, my prized possession was a metal Star Wars-themed lunch box. After school one day, another student ripped it from my hands. I helplessly watched in horror as my classmate threw it to the ground and violently stomped it into an unrecognizable heap of junk. I came home covered in tears of shame and rage. After a few months, I never thought about it again ... until I was almost thirty years old and on a retreat to prepare for ordination to the priesthood.

That childhood memory — and the attendant outrage — came back afresh. My spiritual director helped me in the process of acknowledging that I was angry because that kid owed me my lunch box. Then she helped me, through the grace of Jesus, to forgive the debt. Almost immediately I felt a new peace. I was amazed that I hadn't forgotten what I had lost, even from years before. Aren't we human beings simply amazing at remembering what people owe us?

We see this week in Jesus' parable a servant who is forgiven much but then commands another servant: "Pay back what you owe!" He can't forget or let go of how he was wronged. He remembers — and he becomes a monster because of it. If only he had remembered not only the debts owed to him but also his greater debt owed to — and forgiven by — his master. It's natural for us to remember what others owe us. But when we contextualize those offenses in Jesus' mercy toward us and them, we're free to be merciful like the Master and less like a monster who never forgets.

MEET ST. CHARLES' NEW TEACHING PARISH SEMINARIAN

Hello! My name is Tim Heyrman, and I am entering my third of six years at St. Francis de Sales Seminary. I am from New Berlin, WI, and my family consists of my parents and one younger brother. I attended Holy Apostles

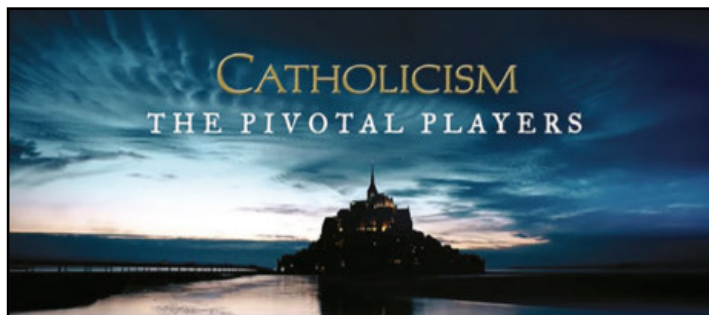
Grade School and Catholic Memorial High School (class of 2012). I love playing sports, and in high school, I played volleyball and tennis. From there, I went to UW-Madison to study accounting (class of 2017), and during my time in Madison, I met none other than Deacon Sweeney! We had an accounting class together, and during my junior year, he invited me to his men's small group. I only went once to the small group that semester, but funny enough, the reading and topic that we were discussing that day was about dating – it's obvious how that worked out...

So... how did I get here? During my time in Madison, God slowly started to reveal a call to the priesthood. When I arrived at college, I was very focused on school, a career, and partying. During those first three years of college, I often attended Sunday Mass and was interested in getting more involved at the Catholic center but was very pre-occupied with other commitments. During my 4th year, I went through a pretty big interior conversion and got very involved at St. Paul's Catholic Center. While the Lord touched me in several ways during that year, it was a retreat in the Fall that springboarded my life of faith and relationship with God. Between a confession that unburdened my heart, a powerful encounter with Jesus in Eucharistic adoration, a new commitment to daily prayer, and the support of a couple key friends at St. Paul's, my life following that retreat was changed.

The following summer (2016), I was invited by a friend to Cor Jesu at St. Robert's in Shorewood. At Cor Jesu, I met Fr. Luke Strand and was encouraged by him and another priest to think about the priesthood. Since then, priesthood has been on my radar. I spent 4 years after college (2017-2021) working for FOCUS (The Fellowship of Catholic University Students) as a campus missionary at the University of Minnesota-Duluth. Over that time as a missionary, I believe that Jesus showed me repeatedly that He is inviting me to become a priest. During the first two years of seminary, he has continued to confirm that call.
