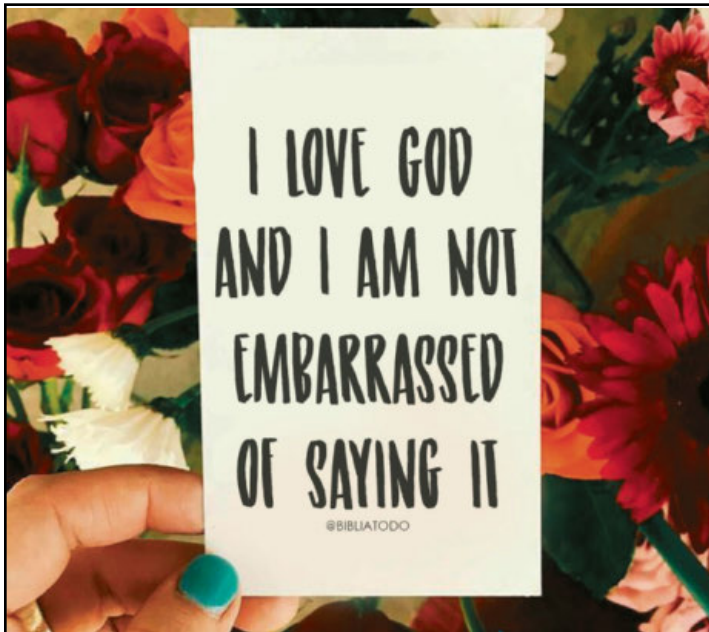

THIS WEEKEND'S GOSPEL MEDITATION

12TH SUNDAY OF EASTER

When I was in middle school, there were times I didn't want my fellow students to see my parents drop me off or pick me up in the school parking lot. I was embarrassed of my parents. Why? I have no idea. Maybe it was our station wagon. Or I didn't want to look like a little kid. But in retrospect, that was a silly thing to do. I was a kid. And I had two parents who loved me and had built a wonderful family. I was afraid of the other kids' judgment. How silly! I should have been afraid of forgetting or downplaying my family, which is where my identity had its deep roots.

This is a way to understand Jesus' words to his disciples this Sunday when he says, "Don't be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul; rather, be afraid of the one who can destroy both soul and body in Gehenna." Fear, in this sense, refers to where we find our deepest identity and our highest love. That's why Jesus says next that when we acknowledge him before others, he will acknowledge us before the Father. It doesn't mean we're brash or boastful. But rather we unhesitatingly and humbly embrace our identity as followers of Jesus and children of God the Father. After all, if we love who we are and where we come from, who cares what the other kids think about us?

Why did you decide to join Becoming Fully Catholic (BFC)?

When I decided to pursue Catholicism, I sought connections with St. Charles when I stumbled upon the BFC program and signed up. I thought, "Better late than never." I was very fortunate to have someone who is a second mother to me guide me in the right direction. She is an absolute role model, and I knew I wanted to be just as strong and confident in my faith for my kids someday as she is. I strongly believe that BFC chose me; I just listened, no matter how afraid I was at the time.

BFC did so much for me. It helped me gain a tremendous depth of understanding of the Catholic teachings, the symbolism, and the tradition going into each reception. BFC discussed what each reception represented and the high importance of why we do what we do. Each class was so fulfilling with information that BFC had rehearsals for each reception, making sure that I was not only confident but also prepared for the commitment. During each reception, I could feel the presence of Jesus. Some days were challenging and emotional, but Jesus was constant in his comfort. I could feel the spirit in me growing and drawing me closer to Him. My prayers deepened, my heart softened and my mind grew quieter listening for Jesus. The feeling of accepting Jesus through the Eucharist is so undeserving and whole. BFC was by my side the whole time and accepted all of my questions. (Trust me, I had a lot of questions.)

The best piece of advice I could give to someone who is considering becoming Catholic but is afraid of the process would be to pray over it. God will lead your heart; you just have to be willing, not be afraid, and trust the process. You need to let go of your pride and stubbornness and allow your heart to remain soft the truth prevails within the teachings, and you will have such amazing relationships form that you will NEVER be alone.

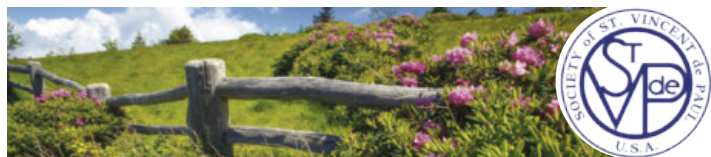

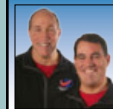
