

THIRD SUNDAY IN ADVENT (GAUDETE SUNDAY)

Certain Sundays throughout the liturgical year have taken their names from the first word in Latin of the Introit, the entrance antiphon at Mass. Gaudete Sunday is one of these.

Gaudete Sunday is a joyous celebration. Although it takes place during the usually penitential period of Advent, Gaudete Sunday serves as a mid-point break from the austere practices to rejoice in the nearness of Jesus' return in three ways.

When is Gaudete?

Gaudete Sunday is the third Sunday of Advent. The date usually falls between December 11 to 17 each year. This year it falls on Dec. 17.

Where Does the Name Come From?

The Introit for Gaudete Sunday, in both the Traditional Latin Mass and the Novus Ordo, is taken from Philippians 4:4-5: "Gaudete in Domino semper" ("Rejoice in the Lord always").

Priest Clothing

Like Lent, Advent is a penitential season, so the priest normally wears purple vestments. But on Gaudete Sunday, having passed the midpoint of Advent, the Church lightens the mood a little, and the priest may wear rose vestments. The change in color provides us with encouragement to continue our spiritual preparation – especially prayer and fasting – for Christmas.

Decor

For this same reason of lightening the mood, the third candle of the Advent wreath, first lit on Gaudete Sunday, is traditionally rose-colored.



Why I go to Adoration:

Growing up I was a "Cradle Catholic." I went to Church, went to Catholic schools because my parents told me to but was missing the importance.

As an adult, I knew I needed to own my faith and learn more. I read books about my faith and went to seminars on various Catholic subjects.

When joining the first small group of St. Charles many years ago, I learned about Adoration. One day I decided to go. I have been going to Adoration ever since.

Imagine if you attended a championship sporting event of some kind or a concert that was so incredible that you couldn't get it out of your mind for days. The high that you feel is priceless, long lasting, and exhilarating. Adoration is exactly that for me. Spending time with the "King of the World." Oh and did I mention it is FREE?

What do I do when I get to Adoration?

I adore Him, letting Him know that I know how GREAT He is. He is our King, He is our creator, He is our Teacher, He is our Heavenly Father, He is Wisdom, He is Almighty.

CATECHESIS OF THE GOOD SHEPHERD (CGS) **CORNER**

WATER

The 'sign' of saving water appears throughout the Bible.

"In the beginning" God hovered over the waters, separating the land and sea.

The cleansing waters of the flood and the covenant with Noah.

The parting of the Red Sea and the salvation of the Hebrews.

The flowing of blood and water from Jesus' side on the cross.

The commission to the apostles - go and baptize all.

God designed our Sacraments to use elements of everyday life because they are accessible and because He knows we need things we can see and smell and touch to think about the more important things that we can't see. Watch with your child for the uses of water in our church and wonder with them about the meaning of water in Mass.

For children ages 1-3: Model using the holy water font to bless yourself. Give your child plenty of time to try this themselves.

For children ages 3-8: Watch closely with them for the drop of water placed in the wine as the chalice is prepared. Ponder, "Can people and animals live without water?"

Wonder aloud why the priest washes his hands before the consecration. Stop by the baptismal font and ponder why water is poured over the baptized. "What kind of life does this baptismal water give us?"

Holy water is a "sacramental" which can help us encounter God. Consider having a holy water font in your home to bring this encounter to your family every day. What a great gift!


